

The CD includes masters and directions for each project to be printed out. Instructions, teacher helps, diagrams, and pictures are provided to make each project and put the final Lapbook together.




God's Hand in History Lapbook Series: The Early Church & the Middle Ages


During the Renaissance, how did people change in their view of God and man?

- Double Trouble Game




God's Hand in History Lapbook Series: The Reformation
